5. How would you explain verse 16 to a non-Christian, particularly one with high moral standards?
6. What convinced you that trying to live up to religious rules couldn’t change you on the inside? In what ways are you still susceptible to getting caught up in rule keeping?
7. Does the Gospel message excite you as much as it does Paul? Why or why not? What could help you experience its life and vitality again?
