4. How does verse 30 give a stern warning to the Judaizers? What is God saying to you in this passage?
5. Do you feel more like Hagar (a slave to rules) or Sarah (a free, loved and forgiven Christian)? Explain.
6. What convinced you that trying to live up to religious rules couldn't change you on the inside? In what area are you still susceptible to getting caught up in rule keeping?
7. How can you live out your freedom in Christ, and still please Him with your sacrificial obedience?
