* Christianity is a **FELLOWSHIP**, not a **SOLO ACT**.

- 6. How are you experiencing the fellowship with God and other Christians that John describes?
- 7. Compare John 15:11 with I John 1:4. How has your salvation contributed to your joy? What are your three greatest challenges for living a daily joyous life?
