1. What part of the text or message had the greatest impact on you? Where were you most encouraged, intrigued, or challenged?
2. In verse 5, what does the word *light* mean, in the way John uses it here? (See also Matt. 11:26-27; Gal. 1:11-12). Does it also mean the same thing in vs. 7?
3. Look again at Gal. 1:11-12. When Christians share the gospel message with non-Christians today, how can they be certain it is the gospel from Jesus Christ, and not merely a gospel that comes from man?
4. Look closely at 2 Cor. 4:3-6. What do these verses tell us about *Satan's* strategy and about *God's* strategy in their dealings with human beings?
5. How would you explain vs. 6 to a small child?
6. If you had to argue for the reality of the Gospel by giving one example of how you have changed as a result of your faith, what would you share?
