– Ezekiel 48:35 –

“And the name of the city from that time on will be: THE LORD IS THERE.”

1. Jehovah Shammah is a Person

“The Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us.” (John 1:14)

2. Jehovah Shammah is Present within Us

“He anointed us, set His seal of ownership on us, and put His Spirit in our hearts as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come.” (2 Cor. 1:22)

3. Jehovah Shammah is Preparing a Place for Us

“And if I go to prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with Me that you also may be where I am.” (John 14:3)

Application Questions. . .

1. What part of the text or message had the greatest impact on you? Where were you most encouraged, intrigued, or challenged?
2. Compare Ps. 10:1 with Ps. 46:1. How can both be true? Even though He has promised to never desert us (Heb. 13:5), we sometimes may *feel* deserted. What causes this and how would you prescribe the cure?
3. How does Ezekiel's promise (48:35) point to the Person and culminating work of Jesus?
4. Paraphrase the “business deal” of 2 Cor. 1:22 in modern terms. How have you experienced this spiritual “new deal”?
5. What evidence (fruit) can you offer that Jehovah Shammah is present in your life?
6. If *hope* is defined as our “eager and confident expectation of what God has promised,” then where is *your* hope? What from this study can you eagerly and confidently expect from the fact God has revealed Himself as Jehovah Shammah?
