Application Questions. . .

- What part of the text or message had the greatest impact on you? Where were you most encouraged, intrigued, or challenged?
- 2. Look again at vs. 13. How often do you notice hatred from the world, and how surprised are you to notice it?
- 3. Have you ever wondered what love is? Look again at verse 16. Spend a moment with this truth. Just sit here. How is this verse different from what TV, magazines and the world declare is love?
- 4. Why is it impossible to claim to love Jesus and not love fellow believers? In what ways are Christ and our loving one another connected?
- 5. What are some ways you can lay down your life for another person apart from physical death?
- 6. How is Jesus' love portrayed in Matt. 9:9-13 and Luke 7:36-39? In our culture, do you think Jesus is still thought of as a friend of sinners? Why or why not?
- 7. How could we show His love in such a way that people are attracted to Jesus, the One who truly loves them? Can you think of any things we should stop doing?
