5. What are some ways our culture changes the gospel today? How do churches add to the gospel?
6. In what ways is the gospel offensive to modern-day American life? How can being ashamed of the gospel affect the way we interact with non-Christians (Rom. 1:16)?
7. What biblical example could you share with someone to help them see the forgiveness of Christ when they have seen their sin?
