Application Questions. . .

1. What part of the text or message had the greatest impact on you? Where were you most encouraged, intrigued, or challenged?
2. In Gen. 15:1-2 Abraham acknowledged God as Adonai with his lips, but in his heart he still struggled with doubt. Where do you find yourself saying, "*God I know You're sovereign, but...?*"
3. How is God the Lord of modern day affairs? Of your life? What personal demands does God's lordship make on you?
4. How would you distinguish between an initial point of surrender to the Lord, and an ongoing, lifelong process of surrender in a believer's life? What is the connection between the two? Why are both important?
5. Discuss why you *agree* or *disagree*: "The person who has never acknowledged Christ's right to rule over his/her life has no basis for assurance of salvation."
6. What difference does it make that Jesus truly is the reigning King and Lord over all? How does that truth affect your daily life?
