### 1. The Context

*“So Gideon built an altar to the LORD there and called it The LORD is Peace...”*  
– Judges 6:24

### 2. The Application

*Jesus alone is the answer to the 3-Headed Dragon:*

A. The Dragon of DISOBEDIENCE.

B. The Dragon of DISTRESS.

C. The Dragon of DISCORD.

*“You will keep in perfect peace him whose mind is steadfast, because he trusts in You. Trust in the LORD forever, for the LORD, the LORD, is the Rock eternal.”*

– Isaiah 26:3-4

#### Application Questions. . .

1. What part of the text or message had the greatest impact on you? Where were you most encouraged, intrigued, or challenged?
2. When you get to heaven and meet Gideon, what's the first question you'd like to ask him?
3. In your own words, how would you describe the *beauty* of Num. 6:24-26? What makes this blessing so appealing?
4. As you reflect on Jesus' promises in John 14:23-27; 16:33, both He and the world offer a form of peace, love and love. How have you experienced each of these? What is different between them?
5. Which of the three 'dragons' represent the biggest threat to your current peace quotient?
6. In a typical day, how often would the commands in Phil. 4:4-7 offer useful and timely guidelines for your immediate situation? Which stands out to you the most? Why?
7. Close with 2 Cor. 13:11. If God had written this only for *you*, which words or phrases do you think He would have underlined? Explain.
