3. What do you think are the causes for believers to “fall asleep” in their faith? What would it mean to wake up?
4. Notice the six words included in the list of sinful actions in vs. 13. How would you rank them according to their prevalence in our community?
5. Paul says we need to stop thinking about how to gratify the desires of the sinful nature. We live in a culture that regularly invites us to do the opposite. How? How can we change our thinking about this?
6. If God had written this passage only for *you*, which words or phrases do you think He would have underlined? Why?
7. How would describe the biggest change that being clothed with Christ has made in your lifestyle?
