#### Application Questions. . .

1. What part of the text or message had the greatest impact on you? Where were you most encouraged, intrigued, or challenged?
2. Why does Jesus' claim in John 14:6 rankle people so much?
3. Why can't all religions lead to God? What is unique about faith in Jesus Christ and repentance as the only way to a relationship with the God of the Bible (Luke 24:45-48)?
4. After reading Acts 4, when, if ever, do you think that Peter's response to the political and religious leaders would appropriate for a Christian today? How do reconcile this (vv18-21) with Romans 13:1-4?
5. Why is it so important to articulate the reason for the hope we have with *gentleness* and *respect* (I Peter 3:15)?
6. Notice that John 14 begins, "Do not let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God; trust also in Me." Discuss where you find troubles in your life that directly link to parts of your life where you don't trust/believe in God. Or, what troubles have found comfort in belief in God?
