Application Questions. . .

1. What part of the text or message had the greatest impact on you? Where were you most encouraged, intrigued, or challenged?
2. What is significant about the focus of Israel's first military battle being placed on what happens on the hill with Moses instead of on what happens with Joshua on the battlefield?
3. What do you think is the significance of Moses' raised hands? Is there a connection with Psalm 138:1-3?
4. How does the name Jehovah Nissi give you more insight into God's character?
5. Being as practical as possible, describe what it looks like to have the Lord as our Banner in our every day lives. What does it look like for our identity to be based in Christ?
6. Ask someone who knows you well: *“Based on what you know of me, what 3 things would you say are most important in my life?”* Listen humbly and ask the Lord to reveal any banners He'd have you surrender and replace with Him.
