Application Questions. . .

4. From Matt. 24:36-44, what ways is the Flood like the second coming of Christ? Think about your faithfulness in a faithless world. How do you "keep watch"?
5. Unpack that phrase "holy fear" (Heb. 11:7). How would you describe it in your own words? How does it *differ* from the fear mentioned in 2 Tim. 1:7 & 1 John 4:18?
6. Why is it so important to articulate the reason for the hope we have with *gentleness* and *respect* (1 Peter 3:15)?
