Application Questions. . .

1. What part of the text or message had the greatest impact on you? Where were you most encouraged, intrigued, or challenged?
2. Since Abraham was a man who lied and made some terrible decisions, why do you think he is in this list?
3. He was on a faith-quest, looking for a city (v. 10) and a country (vv. 14-16). How does his faith-journey encourage yours?
4. What does it mean practically to set our hearts and minds on things above (Col. 3)?
5. Do you ever feel a pull to instant gratification in your faith and prayers? Explain
6. Is there something God has called you to do or a situation He has put you in which you don't fully understand or see the purpose of? How do we thrive in these situations?
7. What have you found helpful as you try to believe God's promises when they don't look like they're coming true?
8. Read vss. 13-16 aloud. What does it mean to *you* to be an alien or stranger on earth?
