Application Questions. . .

1. What part of the text or message had the greatest impact on you? Where were you most encouraged, intrigued, or challenged?
2. Based on what we read in Hebrews 11, why do think Enoch was included in the list of heroes of the faith?
3. Enoch walked with God. If someone wrote down those same words about you — that you “walked with God” — what exactly would you want them to mean?
4. Walking with God brings change which can cause fear. What fears can keep a person from fully walking with God?
5. What other commitments, temptations, or distractions keep us walking only *partially* with God? What are some lessons you have learned by walking partially with God?
6. What is the relationship between our *lifestyle* and simple faith? How does our life verify our faith?
7. How important is it to you that the children in your life (church) grow up to understand and embrace Matt. 6:33? How can you help?
