Application Questions. . .

1. What part of the text or message had the greatest impact on you? Where were you most encouraged, intrigued, or challenged?
2. These are perhaps the most well-known words of Jesus from the cross. What makes them so powerful & memorable?
3. How has your Christian walk been affected by a *proper* or *improper* understanding of the finished work of Jesus?
4. Jesus didn't just 'survive' the cross, He set out for the cross (Jn. 10:17-18). What is the difference? Why does it matter?
5. Suppose a good friend who went off to another church where they were constantly focusing on demons and banishing them from your life. How would Jesus' finished work address that? (See Col. 2:14-15)
6. Look at the implications of the Jesus' finished work through Paul's description of the Gospel in II Tim. 1:7-12. What 'gospel fact' stands out the most to you and why?
7. Of all you have learned in this series, what one truth are you the *most* thankful for?
