Application Questions. . .

1. What part of the text or message had the greatest impact on you? Where were you most encouraged, intrigued, or challenged?
2. Of the most important event and truths surrounding Jesus' death, burial and resurrection, which do you think are the easiest for Christians to forget?
3. Why is Jesus' question, "Who do you say that I am?" (vs. 29) so important?
4. Who did the people in Jesus' day think He was? Who do people today say He is? What about you — how has your answer changed over time?
5. What would you say to the person who said, "If Jesus works for you, that's great, but He's not for me"?
6. Is Jesus' death, burial and resurrection for you more a dispassionate fact, or an emotional experience? Why? How does the Gospel affect your life on a daily basis?
