5. Of the four qualities mentioned in verse 2, which represents the biggest challenge for you at present? Why?
6. To what extent would you say the opening words in Col. 3:15 are an accurate reflection of your own heart at this time in your life?
7. Close with 2 Cor. 13:11. If God had written this only for *you*, which words or phrases do you think He would have underlined? Explain
