5. What does God do when you need discipline? When you need relief? How does this compare to God's actions in this passage?
6. In telling others that Jesus died to take away their sins, what responses do you get: Lazy indifference? Sincere gratitude? Zealous devotion? What might help your message have more impact?
7. Has your familiarity with Jesus (from Sunday School stories, Christian school, etc.) ever kept you from seeing who He really is? What can remove the blinders?
8. What is the main reason you follow Jesus?
