Application Questions. . .

1. What part of the text or message had the greatest impact on you? Where were you most encouraged, intrigued, or challenged?
2. In John 1:1-18, why do you think John called Jesus “the Word”? How might that be related to Moses’ promise in Deut. 18:15, 18-19?
3. How is Jesus the ‘*explanation*’ of God (Jn. 1:18, NASB)? How did He make the gospel clearer for us?
4. In what ways are Jesus and Moses similar? In what ways is Jesus greater? Why is that important (Heb. 3:1-14)?
5. In Hebrews 3, how susceptible do you think Christians in general are today to what the author warns against in vs. 12 (compare it with Deut. 18:19; Acts 3:22-23)?
6. In Hebrews 3:13, what role does Christian community play in keeping one another focused on Christ?
7. When did you have a spiritual breakthrough in your life of understanding who Jesus was? What happened?
8. As *THE* Prophet, Jesus deserves our ultimate attention. What has a tendency to distract you from listening to Him?
