#### Application Questions. . .

5. Note some of the ways the Genesis 22 account gives us glimpses of Jesus. Which one is the most meaningful to you?
6. What does it tell us about the faithfulness of God and His purposes throughout history?
7. Since God already knows everything, why do you think He told Abraham, "*Now I know that you fear God...*" (in verse 12)?
8. In vs. 12, what does it mean to 'fear' God and how is that fear related to "withholding" or 'surrendering' things to Him? (Rom. 12:1)
