

Exodus and the Passover Lamb

– Exodus 12 –

1. The Refusal of Pharaoh

2. The Requirements of the Passover

(1) The lamb must be chosen

(2) The lamb must be unblemished – without defect

(3) The lamb must be slaughtered at twilight

(4) The lamb must have no broken bones

(5) The lamb's blood must be applied

(6) The lamb sacrificed must be eaten

Application Questions. . .

1. What part of the text or message had the greatest impact on you? Where were you most encouraged, intrigued, or challenged?
2. Read Exodus 12:29-32. How did this plague lead the successful release of the Israelites? How is it ironic (Ex. 1:22)?
3. Why do you think people disregard God's warnings today?
4. Look again at vss. 7-13. These instructions are intended to leave Israel in a state of readiness. Jesus tells us to be ready at all times for His return (Matt. 24:36ff). How can we prepare ourselves?
5. How does this passage help you see the purpose for Jesus' death and shed blood (I Peter 1:17-21)?
6. Note verses 26-27. What 'habits' or 'memorials' could you practice in your home that would cause those around you to ask, "Why are you doing this?"
7. Of all that you see in this chapter and study, what one truth are you most thankful for, because of it's personal significance to you? How should it change the way you pray, think or act this week?
