#### Application Questions. . .

1. What part of the text or message had the greatest impact on you? Where were you most encouraged, intrigued, or challenged?
2. At first glance, how does this Beatitude make you feel? Does it bring you hope or despair? Why?
3. One element of purity of heart is singleness in our love and pursuit of God. What would singleness of heart in your love for God look like? (Ps. 86:11)
4. In contrast, what does a divided heart look like in real life? For you, what things keep you from having singleness of heart in your love for God and pursuit of Him?
5. Jesus had strong words for the Pharisees who had a ‘*surface-only*’ faith. What are some ways we live ‘*outside/in*’? What are some ways we can live ‘*inside/out*’? (Matt. 15:16-20; 23:25-28; Ezek. 11:19)
6. Why is honesty with ourselves, others and God such an important part of our purity?
7. For the pure in heart, when does the promise of seeing God happen? Now or in the future, or both? (Eph. 1:17-19; 2 Cor. 3:17-18; 4:6; I Jn. 3:1-3; Rev. 22:4-5)
