Application Questions. . .

1. What part of the text or message had the greatest impact on you? Where were you most encouraged, intrigued, or challenged?
2. When you meet Abraham and Sarah in heaven, what's the first question you'd like to ask each of them?
3. What do the following passages teach us about the faith of Abraham? (a) Gen. 12:1, 4; Heb. 11:8-9 (b) Heb. 11:10 (c) Heb. 11:17-19 (d) Gen 15:6; Rom. 4:20-21
4. "After this" (Gen. 15:1) shows that God's word is connected to what has just happened. Why do you think Abram needs to be told, "Do not be afraid"? Have you had a similar experience?
5. God promised to be Abram's shield and very great reward. How does this promise encourage you in an area with which you may be struggling?
6. Notice God's words to Abraham in 22:12. Based on Abraham's example, what does it mean to "fear" God? How might that intersect with our daily lives today?
7. Which lessons in faith from Abraham (question 3) do you need to apply more often in your life? What keeps you from demonstrating faith like Abraham?
