Applying it Today. . .

1. God is ***made strong in our weakness.***

Application Questions. . .

1. What part of the text or message had the greatest impact on you? Where were you most encouraged, intrigued, or challenged?
2. None of us like to wait, but waiting through trial and hardship is especially difficult. Compare Acts 7:1-7 and 2 Pet. 3:8-9. How do they relate to Israel's situation in the opening of Exodus? How is relevant to your current circumstances?
3. Despite living under the rule of a fearsome Pharaoh (Ex. 1:15-20), the Hebrew midwives walked in fear of God. Who are what are you most likely to fear more than God? What is the secret to fearing God more than the "pharaohs" in our lives?
4. Have you ever thought, "If God would just tell me what to do, I would do it."? How does the story of Moses and burning bush (Ex. 3) challenge that statement. Why do we still hesitate to obey, even when the will or Word of God is clear?
5. Can you think of a personal example of how you have experienced the truth of one or both of the application points?
6. How or when has God reassured you of His presence and power (Rom. 15:13)?
