3. In what ways have you been used to meet the needs of needy people you encounter? How can you make the Gospel relevant when you help needy people?
4. Examine Isaiah 53:1-11. What correlation do you see between this Scripture passage and Jesus? How are we as guilty as the crowd Peter spoke to in Acts 3 for the murder of the Messiah?
5. How has the Lord given you “refreshment” after repenting? Consider Hebrews 4:1-13, how do Acts 3: 19 and 20 connect to Hebrews 4?
6. What from Acts 3:19-26 reveals that the opportunity to repent and turn away is for a limited time? How does this truth impact your behavior?
7. What does Acts 3:26 show us of the priority of God? How should this affect us?
