2. What impacted you most from this passage / sermon? What questions do you still have about these verses? What challenged you? What encouraged you?
3. Where does Peter's boldness come from [Acts 4:8]? What does that say to us as Christ's followers today?
4. What is the significance of Jesus being the "cornerstone" and One by which we must be saved" [Acts 4:11-12]? How does this bolster your faith?
5. Why does persecution never snuff out the Church? What encouragement do you find in the growth of the Church despite all of the persecution it has faced and does face today?
