Application Questions:

1. What impacted you most from this passage / sermon? What questions do you still have about these verses? What challenged you? What encouraged you?
2. If someone asked you to define what Christians mean by the "Gospel", how would you answer?
3. How does Peter use the Old Testament in his sermon [Joel 2:28-32; Psalm 16:8-11; 110:1]? What might this tell us about how we should read the Old Testament?
4. What does it mean that Jesus is "both Lord and Christ" [v. 36]? What evidences does Peter give of this in his sermon? What does it mean for you personally that Jesus is "both Lord and Christ"?
5. Why is it a comfort to Christians to know that there is no hiding from God? Why don't we have to fear the day of the Lord?
