Application Questions:

1. What impacted you most from this passage / sermon? What questions do you still have about these verses? What challenged you? What encouraged you?
2. What can we learn about how to understand the Old Testament from Luke 24:25-27 & 44-47? How did this impact the Apostles in Acts 1? How does Peter use the Old Testament in this chapter? What might this tell us about reading and teaching the Old Testament?
3. What does Judas's story [Psalm 69:25, 109:8; Matthew 26:24; Luke 22:22; Acts 1:16-20, 25] teach about the pitfalls of spiritual leadership? How should we pray for and support our leaders?
4. Think about the beauty of the Gospel [Romans 2:4, 5:8-11, 8:1; 2 Peter 3:9; Luke 6:35-36; Ephesians 2:4-10] - how does it motivate and empower us to find our place in God's unfolding story?
5. How do Hebrews 8:10 and 2 Peter 1:3 encourage you? How does James 3:13-18 help us assess if we've sought God's will or our own understanding?
