3. What does it mean to “make disciples”? How do we make disciples? How do we know if someone is becoming a disciple?
4. How does our love for one another and unity together [John 13:34-35 & 17:23] connect to fulfilling the Great Commission [Matt. 28:18-20]?
5. How does Jesus’s example motivate our evangelism and missions? How does He empower discipleship in the church and evangelism and missions from the Church?
6. What ministries in the Church have helped you become a disciple? What area of Church ministry do you want to be increasingly involved in?
